#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

- 1.1 Roll Call:
  - 1.1.1 Meeting called to order at 11:01 a.m. by Steve Segner, Committee Chair. Roll call was taken via ZOOM teleconference and in-person and a quorum was established.
- 1.2 Introduction of Members and Guests:
  - 1.2.1 Pedro Rodriquez, and Tom Morris from NACOG were introduced to the committee.

### 2. PUBLIC FORUM:

2.1 No public comments were received during the public forum.

#### 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

3.1 Approval of the meeting minutes for July 18, 2024, was moved by Committee member Romig, second by Committee member O'Donnell and unanimously approved.

#### 4. REGULAR BUSINESS:

- 4.1 Sedona Shuttle Connect (SSC) service update:
  - 4.1.1 The following represents the connect service KPI data from August 29, 2024, through Sunday November 17, 2024 (first 49 days of service):
    - Passengers: 2,523
    - Trips booked: 1,525
    - Trips completed: 1,358
    - Average wait time 4.81 minutes
    - Most requested trips: Uptown, Gallery District, West Sedona shopping district, trailhead park & rides.
  - 4.1.2 SCC Marketing efforts:
    - Residential mailers w tickets to go out early January
    - Social media campaign to begin with the next few weeks
    - DMO to market the service through its channels
    - Regular email updates to hotels and lodging council.
  - 4.1.3 Committee SCC Recommendations:
    - Email for hotels to send out to their guests in advance of their arrival. <RW> to have the transit marketing group draft an email. <SS> will work with the hotel owners to have them distribute it.
    - Consider a future SSC service island at Chapel of the Holy Cross.
    - Provide Friday & Saturday nighttime SSC service as a pilot during spring break season. (March - April)

- 4.2 SSC Special Event Promotions & Sponsorships:
  - Promotion kit developed and provided to Parks & Rec Department
  - Vendors to be required to promote SSC service as a condition of the event permit.
  - Riders raffle to be conducted on all city sponsored special events held at Posse Ground Park.
- 4.3 Review Sedona Transit Implementation Plan (STIP) annual review schedule.
  - Review annually in advance of City Council priority setting workshop.
- 4.4 Verde Shuttle boardings by stop analysis & bus stop improvement project.
  - Goal: To remove or upgrade stops for the Verde Shuttle within the 89A West Sedona corridor that are forcing the service to conduct street stops & impede traffic.
  - Committee member O'Donnell suggested that Inbound & outbound stops be added between Andante & Dry Creek Rd -- near the future Circle K project.
- 4.5 Trailhead Shuttles Ridership by hour by trailhead report
  - Move to next meeting

- 5.1 MV Transportation Inc service update (GM Division 536)
  - Staffing is stable, moral is high.
  - MV has receive multiple compliments on all services.
- 5.2 Trailhead Shuttle, Verde Shuttle, & Sedona Shuttle Connect Updates Robert Weber, Transit Administrator:
  - Trailhead shuttle route ridership is down by 8.25% for the first four months of the fiscal year. It is speculated that the decrease is due to construction on I17, 89A and the economy (inflation).
  - Committee Chair Segner felt it was due to a lapse in marketing efforts and suggested renewed focus be brought to that effort.
